Role Overview

Working under the Harvesting Manager's directions, the Haulage Operative will be responsible for moving the production from the growing houses to the Packhouse and ensuring all necessary documents and records are up-to-date.

Main Duties

- Collecting mushrooms from the growing houses
- Ensuring growing houses are always fully equipped with packaging, crates and dollies etc
- Completing and keeping all the necessary documents and records up-to-date (e.g. punnets' issue record, cold room temperature checks, dispatch records etc.)
- Loading and unloading Lorries

- Be conscientious with strong attention to detail
